Serpent's Whisper Infinity Scarf



Difficulty

Easy

Materials

- 100% Acrylic, 100gr, weight #4 yarn, approx 400 yards in Lime Green and some in white
- **Hook:** US Size I-9 (5 mm)
- [Yarn Needle](#), [Scissors](#), [Measuring Tape](#)

Gauge

- 13 st X 7 rows (4" X 4")

Sizes

- This sample is 8" X 60"

Stitch Key

- **Ch** = Chain
- **Sc** = Single Crochet
- **St** = Stitch
- **Dc** = Double Crochet
- **Yo** = Yarn Over

Specialty Stitches

FpDc = Front Post Double Crochet [Yo, insert hook under the post of next st, yo, draw up a loop (3 loops on hook), yo, draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops on hook), yo, draw through last 2 loops on hook]

Notes

- This pattern uses US terminology
- The pattern is worked in rows
- Ch 2 at the beginning of the row does count as st
- This pattern uses pattern repeats.
- You can work this pattern with one color or multiple as you wish- I used two solid colors
- This pattern uses **multiples of 7+8**

- In this pattern, we use a simple tapestry crochet technique(carrying the yarn)

Instructions

Ch 29

Start with the green color

Row 1: Dc 1 in 4th ch from the hook, dc 1 in the next ch, and across to the end of the row, turn **(26)**

Row 2 : Ch2, dc 1 in next 4 st, skip 1 st, Fpdc in next st, Fpdc 1 in skipped st, *dc 1 in next 5 st, skip 1 st, Fpdc in next st, Fpdc in skipped st, repeat from * one more time, dc 1 in 5 last st turn **(26)**

Row 3: Ch 2, dc 1 in next st, to the end of the row, turn **(26)**

Rows 4-7: repeat rows 2+3

Row 8: Ch2, dc 1 in next 4 st, skip 1 st, Fpdc in next st, Fpdc 1 in skipped st, *dc 1 in next 5 st, skip 1 st, Fpdc in next st, Fpdc in skipped st, repeat from * one more time, dc 1 in 5 last st turn **(26)**

Row 9: Ch 2, dc 1 in next 8 st, change to color white, dc 1 in next 8 st carrying the green color with you, change back to green (leave the white tail behind) dc 1 in last 9 st , turn **(26)**

Row 10: Ch2, dc 1 in next 4 st, skip 1 st, Fpdc in next st, Fpdc 1 in skipped st, dc 1 in next 2 st, change to color white, carrying the green color with you, dc 1 in next 3 st , skip 1 st, Fpdc in next st, Fpdc in skipped st, dc 1 in next 3 st, change back to color green leave the white tail behind, dc 1 in next 2 st, skip 1 st, Fpdc in next, Fpdc in skipped st, dc 1 in 5 last st turn **(26)**

Row 11: Ch 2, dc 1 in next 8 st, change to color white, dc 1 in next 8 st carrying the green color with you, change back to green (leave the white tail behind) dc 1 in last 9 st , turn **(26)**

Cut color white, leaving a short tail to weave in

The pattern row repeat is rows 2-11

For this size, I worked 9 repeats. consider the length you want the scarf to be and calculate the number of repeats.

Finishing

I closed the scarf into an infinity scarf using the tapestry needle and joined both sides

Cut your yarn and weave in the ends.
