# Serpent's Whisper Infinity Scarf



# **Difficulty**

Easy

## **Materials**

- 100% Acrylic, 100gr, weight #4 yarn, approx 400 yards in Lime Green and some in white
- **Hook**: US Size I-9 (5 mm)
- Yarn Needle, Scissors, Measuring Tape

## Gauge

• 13 st X 7 rows ( 4" X 4")

#### Sizes

• This sample is 8" X 60"

# Stitch Key

- Ch = Chain
- **Sc** = Single Crochet
- **St** = Stitch
- **Dc** = Double Crochet
- Yo = Yarn Over

## **Specialty Stitches**

**FpDc** = **Front Post Double Crochet** [Yo, insert hook under the post of next st, yo, draw up a loop (3 loops on hook), yo, draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops on hook), yo, draw through last 2 loops on hook]

#### Notes

- This pattern uses US terminology
- The pattern is worked in rows
- Ch 2 at the beginning of the row does count as st
- This pattern uses pattern repeats.
- You can work this pattern with one color or multiple as you wish- I used two solid colors
- This pattern uses multiples of 7+8

• In this pattern, we use a simple tapestry crochet technique( carrying the yarn)

#### Instructions

#### Ch 29

#### Start with the green color

**Row 1:** Dc 1 in 4th ch from the hook, dc 1 in the next ch, and across to the end of the row, turn **(26)** 

**Row 2:** Ch2, dc 1 in next 4 st, skip 1 st, Fpdc in next st, Fpdc 1 in skipped st, \*dc 1 in next 5 st, skip 1 st, Fpdc in next st, Fpdc in skipped st, repeat from \* one more time, dc 1 in 5 last st turn **(26)** 

**Row 3:** Ch 2, dc 1 in next st, to the end of the row, turn **(26)** 

#### Rows 4-7: repeat rows 2+3

**Row 8:** Ch2, dc 1 in next 4 st, skip 1 st, Fpdc in next st, Fpdc 1 in skipped st, \*dc 1 in next 5 st, skip 1 st, Fpdc in next st, Fpdc in skipped st, repeat from \* one more time, dc 1 in 5 last st turn **(26)** 

**Row 9:** Ch 2, dc 1 in next 8 st, <u>change to color</u> <u>white</u>, dc 1 in next 8 st carrying the green color with you, <u>change back to green</u> ( leave the white tail behind) dc 1 in last 9 st , turn **(26)** 

**Row 10:** Ch2, dc 1 in next 4 st, skip 1 st, Fpdc in next st, Fpdc 1 in skipped st, dc 1 in next 2 st, change to color white, carrying the green color with you, dc 1 in next 3 st, skip 1 st, Fpdc in next st, Fpdc in skipped st, dc 1 in next 3 st, change back to color green leave the white tail behind, dc 1 in next 2 st, skip 1 st, Fpdc in next, Fpdc in skipped st, dc 1 in 5 last st turn **(26)** 

**Row 11:** Ch 2, dc 1 in next 8 st, <u>change to color white</u>, dc 1 in next 8 st carrying the green color with you, <u>change back to green</u> ( leave the white tail behind) dc 1 in last 9 st , turn **(26)** 

# Cut color white, leaving a short tail to weave in

#### The pattern row repeat is rows 2-11

For this size, I worked 9 repeats. consider the length you want the scarf to be and calculate the number of repeats.

## **Finishing**

I closed the scarf into an infinity scarf using the tapestry needle and joined both sides

Cut your yarn and weave in the ends.
