# Ocean Dreams Baby Lovey Crochet Pattern

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## Difficulty

Intermediate

## Materials

**Any cotton or cotton blend yarn weight #3 in 2 colors ( blue & beige).** Use your stash!

**Hook:** US Size (4 mm)

- Yarn Needle, Scissors, Measuring Tape, Amigurumi stuffing

## Gauge

- Blanket: 9 rounds × 15 sts ≈ 4" × 4"

## Sizes

Adjustable depending on the number of rounds

## Stitch Key

- **Ch** = Chain
- **Sc** = Single Crochet
- **Dc** = Double Crochet
- **SIS**t = Slip Stitch

## Notes

- The pattern uses US terminology
- Pattern is worked in rounds.
- Ch1 at the beginning of a round does **not** count as a stitch.
- Ch3 at the beginning of a round **does** count as a stitch.
- You can work this pattern with one or multiple colors; this version uses 2 colors.
- The lovey consists of **the blanket and the head.**

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## Instructions

### The Blanket

**Start with color A ( blue) and change colors every 3 rounds**

Ch 4, join with a Slst to form a circle or use the magic circle.

**Round 1:** Ch 4( counts as dc+ch), \* dc 1 into the ring, Ch 1, repeat from \* 6 more times, Slst to 3rd ch

**Round 2:** Slst into the 1st ch1 space, Ch 3, dc 1 in same ch space, ch 2, \* dc 2 into next ch space, ch 2, repeat from 8 to the end, Slst to 3rd ch

**Round 3:** Slst to next ch space, ch3, dc 1 in same space, ch 2, dc 2 into same space, \*(dc2+ch2+dc2) into next ch space, repeat from \* to the end of the round, Slst to 3rd ch

**Round 4:** Slst to next ch space, ch3, \*(dc2+ch2+dc2) into next ch space, dc1 in next st, skip next 2 st, dc1 in next st, repeat from \* to end of round, change to color beige, Slst to 3rd ch

**Round 5:** Slst to next dc, ch3, dc1 in next st, (dc2+ch2+dc2) in next space, dc2, skip 2 st, \*dc2 in next st, (dc2+ch2+dc2) in next st, dc2, skip 2 st, repeat from \* to end of round, Slst to 3rd ch

**Round 6:** Slst to next dc, ch 3, dc 2, dc2+ch2+dc2) in next ch space, dc 3, skip 2 st, dc 3, repeat from \* to the end of the round, Slst to 3rd ch ( change to color blue)

**Round 7:** Slst to next dc, ch 3, dc3, (dc2+ch2+dc2) in next ch space, dc 4, skip 2 st, dc 4, repeat from \* to the end of the round, Slst to 3rd ch

**Round 8:** Slst to next dc, ch 3, dc 4, dc2+ch2+dc2) in next ch space, dc 5, skip 2 st,

dc 5, repeat from \* to the end of the round, Slst to 3rd ch

**Round 9:** Slst to next dc, ch 3, dc 5, dc2+ch2+dc2) in next ch space, dc 6, skip 2 st, dc 6, repeat from \* to the end of the round, Slst to 3rd ch ( change to color beige)

**Round 10:** Slst to next dc, ch 3, dc 6, (dc2+ch2+dc2) in next ch space, dc 7, skip 2 st, dc 7, repeat from \* to the end of the round, Slst to 3rd ch

**Round 11:** Slst to next dc, ch 3, dc 7, (dc2+ch2+dc2) in next ch space, dc 8, skip 2 st, dc 8, repeat from \* to the end of the round, Slst to 3rd ch

**Round 10:** Slst to next dc, ch 3, dc 8, \*(dc2+ch2+dc2) in next ch space, dc 9, skip 2 st, dc 9 repeat from \* to the end of the round, Slst to 3rd ch

Cut the yarn and weave in ends

### The Head

#### Make two identical circles

Ch3, join with a Slst to form a circle or use the magic circle

**Round 1:** Ch1, sc 8 in circle, Slst to 1st sc

**Round 2:** Ch1, sc 2 in 1st st from hook, sc 2 in next and around to the end of the round, Slst to 1st sc

**Round 3:** Ch 1, sc 1 in 1st st from hook, \*sc 2 in next st, sc 1 in next st, repeat from \* around, Slst to 1st sc

**Round 4:** Ch 1, sc 1 in 1st st from hook, sc 1 in next st,\* sc 2 in next st, sc 1 in next 2 st, repeat from \* around, Slst to 1st sc

**Round 5:** Ch 1, sc 1 in 1st st from hook, sc 1 in next 2 st \*sc 2 in next st, sc 1 in next 3 st, repeat from \* around, Slst to 1st sc

Cut yarn

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## Construction

### Construction of Face

- With yarn or thread, embroider a **V for each eye** and an **X for the mouth** on one circle.
- Join the two head circles with SISt around, leaving a small opening above the eyes (~5 sts).
- Stuff head lightly.
- Ch5, SISt back to head, continue SISt to close the opening. Repeat Ch5/SISt to form the second “ear”
- Cut yarn and weave in ends.

### Attach Head to Blanket

- Join head to center of the blanket using a tapestry needle and yarn.

## Finishing

- Weave in all ends.
- Wash the lovey before gifting.
